

## CLUB BYE- LAWS

**PLAY** Members may play from 12.00 noon on available rinks. Play must be completed by 5.30 pm when there is an evening fixture e.g. County Match, League Match or Friendly so that match organisers are free to choose from all rinks at 6.00 pm.

All players entering internal club competitions **must** have played at least **five** friendlies **before** the competition semi-finals.

**DRESS** **Club Tee Shirts** will be worn for:

- Matches against other clubs
- One Day Competitions and
- Competition Finals.

**Whites** will be worn for matches starting before 6pm and **Greys** for matches starting after 6pm

Greys and Club Tee Shirts or white tops will be worn for roll ups and preliminary rounds of internal competitions.

Blazers are discretionary.

**BOWLS** Club stickers must be attached when playing other clubs.

**FOOTWEAR** Brown, white or grey smooth soled, heel-less shoes to be worn for all matches, whether competitive or social. Sandals must not be worn on the green. Anyone contravening this bye-law has no recourse to compensation in case of injury or skin condition.

**AROUND THE GREEN** Bowlers must use the designated access points to the Green. All marking sticks, mats, bags, etc. must not be left on the edge of green in such a way that could cause an accident. It is the responsibility of all bowlers to take care when going onto or leaving the Green and walking around it. Everyone using the facilities of the Club has a responsibility not only for their own health and safety but for all other users as well.

**RESERVES** Once on the field of play a reserve player has the right to remain there.
